This is to invite you cordially to the 59th meeting of the International Working Group on Data Protection in Telecommunications, which will be held on 25-26 April 2016 at the kind invitation of the Norwegian Data Protection Authority in Oslo. The meeting will start on 25 April at 9.30 hours and end on 26 April at approx. 13.00 hours.

There will be an informal meeting on the evening of Sunday 24 April from 19:00 hours in a pub or restaurant in Oslo (details to be announced).
