Application for Travel Support

I'd like to apply following the guidelines for NCUC Travel Support Policy for ICANN55 Marrakesh

I understand there is limited travel support for members who are actively and verifiably engaged in important policy work and need to attend meetings to represent the Constituency.

Regarding the Eligibility criteria

* I have been a member of NCUC since the second semester of 2015 so I did not vote on the last election but I have engaged in the discussions after it.

* I am actively and verifiably engaged in NCUC's work, as I have answered the calls to participate in two working groups published in the list, initially as observer but as I understand more the functionality of the groups I'll be more active in one. (Groups GNSO New gTLDs subsequent rounds WG and GNSO RDS PDP WG). I've also been recently nominated for the MAG IGF and got shortlisted by NCSG. I've also participated in WSIS+10 NY and as a fellow on ICANN53 (when I began engaging with NCUC).

* I need to be at a ICANN55 because the it will be the first meeting where the working groups I recently joined will have their work discussed and it would be very important for having a more active role on it.

* I agree to participate in any NCUC, NCSG and GNSO meetings held during the meeting;

* I agree to write a brief post-trip blog post for the NCUC website reflecting on the meeting's main developments of relevance to NCUC;

* I did not receive NCUC funding to attend the immediately previous ICANN meeting.

* I agree to make their own travel, accommodation, visa, and related arrangements and be reimbursed after the trip.

About the funding required

I live in Brazil but I will be in Spain before the ICANN55 meeting due to participation in an academic event to which I have received funding (Force11.org - The future of research). Therefore, I'd need funding to go to Morocco from Spain and then, after the event, airfare to Brazil. I am confident the costs of this travel support are way below the US\$ 2000 maximum estimate.
