Other than my work as a researcher on privacy and Internet governance at the Center for Technology and Society in Getulio Vargas Foundation (Rio de Janeiro, Brazil), I have also been taking part in a UNESCO project focused in analyzing multistakeholder participation in IG-related institutions/institutional processes. With that in mind, I see this as an opportunity for me to not only get a better picture of how ICANN's constituencies inter-relate, but mostly as a space where I could get involved with NCUC's work at CCWG-IG, more specifically. For the past few months I have been following NCUC's list and, as a newcomer, my activities have been mostly directed towards organizational and logistical help - helping and reaching out to the list during the elaboration of the Rightscon proposal.

I would also highlight the mentorship process as a fundamental asset to my request for travel support. Besides having access to funds that would further enable my participation at ICANN 58, the mentorship program would be crucial to deepening my knowledge and understanding regarding the politics of participation and the consequences of institutionalizing it (level-wise: national, regional and international - e.g. RIRs; and theme-wise). With that in mind, my objective is to follow the CCWG-IG debates as well as gain greater familiarity with working groups on gTLDs. Copenhagen would be a starting point for me to participate more actively in NCUC both substantively and organizationally. It is part of a capacity building process that will aid me in developing the above-mentioned projects as well as work in NCUC outreach.
