For that, I founded a non-profit organization named "Cox's Bazar Youth Development Society" back in 2014 to educate them. By using the internet, I and my team provided them with free online training and engaged them in different social development activities. So far, my organization has 200+ volunteers. It all happened because of the internet.

I believe in a quote 'think globally, act locally'. So, I have co-founded Lets Learn Coding (LLC), an organization which works for educating financially challenged dropouts with free web development training. At LLC, we also provide free web development courses in our YouTube channel and website for free in the local language so everyone can understand and learn easily. At the beginning of 2018, we started our online platform to empower the students across the country by providing free online courses. My experience of the last six years in national & global development activities taught me some valuable lessons such as to have patience, thinking critically, and communicating with people, emotional intelligence and many more.
